The Teo Chew Association-Temple (TCA) has been a staple in Houston, supporting the greater Houston community since the 1980s. As part of the TCA's mission to support the next generation of the Teo Chew community, we are proud to announce the **third** year of TCA's scholarship. The TCA will award 4 scholarships:

- **Golden Scholarship:** Two (2), \$5,000 Scholarships
- **Silver Scholarship:** Two (2), \$2,500 Scholarships

The scholarships will be awarded on a combination of:

- Academic performance
- Community service
- Leadership activities
- Athletic achievements
- Alignment with TCA's mission of service and community

Eligibility

Applicants must meet all the following:

- Minimum unweighted GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Enrolled or planning to enroll in an accredited U.S. higher-education program for Fall 2026. Eligible applicants include current high school seniors, undergraduates, and graduate students.
- U.S. citizen or U.S. permanent resident.

Priority consideration will be given to applicants with Teo Chew heritage or an established connection to the Temple, but all eligible applicants are welcome.

Reapplication policy: Past recipients of any TCA scholarship are not eligible to apply again.

 - Transcript covering all years to date
 - Test scores
